Abigail Jackson

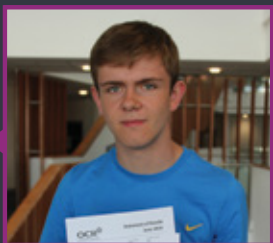
